At all other times during the Board meeting the audience shall not enter into discussions or debates on matters being considered by the Board. No presentation shall exceed five (5) minutes. Delegations of more than five people shall appoint one person to represent their views for (5) minutes allotted. Specific factual information or recitations of existing policy may be furnished in response to inquiries, but the Board may not deliberate, discuss, or make any decision on any subject not on the agenda.
